



## Nina J. Johnson

July 1, 1923 - March 25, 2016

Nina J. Johnson 92 of Markle passed away at 4:35 p.m. Friday (March 25, 2016) at Heritage Pointe in Warren.

She was born on July 1, 1923 in Wells County to James Lewis & Addie (Davison) Gibson. She graduated from Lancaster High School in 1941 and worked with her husband Paul on the family farm and dairy. She was a former member of the Eastern Star in Bluffton and Rockford Friendship Home Econ. Club for many years. Nina was a member of Boehmer United Methodist Church, Liberty Center and a former member of Emmanuel Church in Rockford.
