



Mrs. Nina Jane Meyer

Nina Jane Meyer, 90, of Bluffton, passed away at 12:25 p.m. on Saturday, August 10, 2013, at Christian Care Retirement Community.

She was born in Wells County on February 8, 1923, to John and Vesta (Neff) Eversole. She married Raymond E. Meyer in Bluffton on June 29, 1952. He preceded her in death on July 26, 2002.

Nina Jane was a life-long resident of Wells County. She graduated from Bluffton High School in 1940. She went to McMurray College in Illinois and then to the Lutheran Hospital School of Nursing where she graduated in 1945. She became a registered nurse and worked as a surgical nurse at Lutheran Hospital. She was also a homemaker and assisted her husband in operating the Bluffton Fabric Store from 1967 to 1974.

Nina Jane was a member of the Bluffton Reformed Church, Foltz Club, Tri Kappa Sorority, and she was involved with the Wells County Auxiliary where she donated many hours of service.

She is survived by a son, John E. (Theresa) Meyer of Zionsville, Indiana, a daughter, Karen (Larry) Strahm of Canton, Michigan, four grandchildren, Lauren Strahm of Nashville, Tennessee, Jordyn Strahm of Canton, Michigan, Emma Meyer of Zionsville, and Laura Meyer of Zionsville.
