



Norma Lea Jackson

August 17, 1925 - August 6, 2006

Committal services for Norma Lea Jackson, 80, will be held at 10 a.m. on Monday, Nov. 27 at the Northridge Mausoleum at Fairview Cemetery in Bluffton.

Mrs. Jackson, a former Bluffton resident, died Aug. 6, 2006 in Temple, Tex. She was born Aug. 17, 1925 in Flat Rock, Ill., to Willard R. and Gretna (Pennington) Wampler. She graduated from nursing training at Vincennes Indiana Hospital and became an RN in 1946.

Her marriage on Jan. 23, 1947 was to Dr. Charles E. (Gene) Jackson, who survives.

Dr. and Mrs. Jackson came to Bluffton in 1951 and lived here for 19 years before moving to Grosse Pointe, Mich.

She was a life-long member of the Methodist Church. She was a faithful Christian witness, a Stephen Minister in Grosse Pointe and a participant in The Walk to Emmaus.

In addition to the husband, she is survived by a daughter, Mrs. Charlie (Penny) Stover of Georgetown, Tex., and a son, Dr. Jeffrey A. Jackson of Fishers, Ind. She was preceded in death in May of this year by a daughter, Mrs. Tim (Jan) Byrd.

Also surviving are a brother, Willard R. Wampler Jr. of San Diego, Calif., three grandchildren and one great-grandchild.
