Patricia (Pat) C. Symon, 91, of Bluffton and Adams County passed away on December 28, 2016 at Swiss Village in Berne Indiana.

Patricia was born on July 17, 1925 in Rochester Minnesota to Harold D. and Ella Cary Caylor. Patricia was a graduate of Bluffton High School and Indiana University. She was the widow of William Edward Symon, M.D.

As a homemaker in Bluffton, Patricia was a founding member of Creative Arts and a member of the Bluffton Park Board. Later in life she moved to Adams County. There she lived on a property which she kept as a wildlife habit while working in Medical Records and as the Medical Librarian for the Caylor-Nickel Clinic Hospital. After retirement she continued to enjoy the wildlife habitat while staying involved with family and friends.

Patricia is survived by her children Anne Vanderbilt of Lake Forest, IL, William (Caron) Symon of Grapevine, TX, and John (Maritza) Symon of Bluffton, 7 grandchildren, and 5 great grandchildren.

She was preceded in death her by her parents, husband, one child, James, and her sister, Rebecca Meier.
