



## Patrick A. "Pat" Eisenhut

March 17, 1953 - November 8, 2010

Patrick A. "Pat" Eisenhut, 57, of Bluffton, died at 5:15 a.m. Monday, Nov. 8, 2010, at Meadowvale Health and Rehabilitation Center.

Mr. Eisenhut was born in Allen County on March 17, 1953, to Richard C. Eisenhut and Doris (Gilgen) Leimgruber. He married Jane Rohde in Bluffton on Dec. 17, 1998; she survives.

Pat attended Bluffton High School and in the 1960s he worked at the Steury Bottling Company, and later at Sterling Casting. He attended worship services every Sunday at Meadowvale Health and Rehabilitation Center.

Other surviving relatives include his mother and step father, Jerry Leimgruber, of Bluffton; one daughter, Tabatha Bolton of Rockford, Ohio; one son, Ryan Eisenhut of Bluffton; four brothers, Jody Eisenhut of Cleveland, Ohio, Tony Eisenhut of Craigville, Scott Eisenhut of Bluffton and Shane Leimgruber of Bluffton; two step sisters, Barb Gerber of Zanesville and Brenda Licking of Oro Valley, Ariz; and two grandchildren, Shay Elizabeth Bolton and Riley Bolton.

Pat was preceded in death by his father; and two brothers, Rick Leimgruber and Kim Eisenhut.
