Paul E. Johnson, 89, of Markle, died at 8:25 a.m. Saturday, Dec. 20, 2008, at Meadowvale Health and Rehabilitation Center. Mr. Johnson was born in Liberty Center on June 28, 1919 to Estel A. and Orpha (Marshall) Johnson. He married Nina Gibson in Wells County on June 6, 1943; she survives. Mr. Johnson graduated from Liberty Center High School and worked as a dairy farmer. He was a former Wells County 4-H Horse and Pony leader, a member of Wheels of Yesteryear and the Wells County Coon Hunters Club.
