Pauline R. Markley, 85, of Bluffton, died at 8 p.m. Monday, Feb. 4, 2008, at Bluffton Regional Medical Center.

Born in Wells County to Paul H. and Daisy A. (Kelly) Markley on March 22, 1922, she was a 1940 graduate of Bluffton High School.

Miss Markley worked for Emshwiller and Emshwiller as a book keeper for 25 years, retiring in 1994, and served one term in 1967 as the Bluffton City Clerk/Treasurer under Mayor Charles Decker. She was a member of Sigma Phi Gamma International Sorority since 1940, and the American Legion Auxiliary Post #111 of Bluffton. She was also an active member of the First United Methodist Church in Bluffton, where she taught Sunday School for over 35 years.

Surviving relatives include one nephew, Gary (Diane) Markley of Bluffton; one niece, Cynthia (Tom) Paxson of Bluffton; one sister-in-law, Ruth Markley of Bluffton; two great-nephews, four great-nieces, six great-great-nephews and two great-great-nieces.

Miss Markley was preceded in death by one brother, Robert K. Markley. Funeral services will be at 10:30 a.m. Saturday, at the Thoma/Rich, Chaney & Lemler Funeral Home with the Rev.
