



## Peggy J. Hamilton

June 20, 1917 - March 28, 2011

Peggy J. Hamilton, 93, of Tucson, Ariz., and formerly of Bluffton, passed away at 6:30 a.m. Monday, March 28, 2011, in Tucson.

Peggy was born on June 20, 1917 in Wichita, Kan., to Robert A. and Mona (Small) Crosby. Her parents preceded her in death.

On July 20, 1940, in Laporte, she married A. Walter Hamilton, a prominent local attorney. He preceded her in death on June 17, 1987.

Peggy earned a B.A. Degree from Indiana University in 1939 and was a retired social worker. She resided in Bluffton from 1940 to 2009. In 2009 she moved to Tucson, Ariz. to be closer to her family.

Peggy was a member of the First United Methodist Church of Bluffton and Delta Gamma Sorority. She was a life-long Indiana University Fan.

Peggy is survived by a daughter, Jane (David) Seiller of Tucson, Ariz.; and granddaughter, Allison (Chris) Sandidge of Colorado.

A Graveside Service will be conducted at Fairview Cemetery at 1:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 31, 2011. Mayor Ted Ellis will officiate.
