



Phyllis I. Cassiday

September 26, 1931 - March 26, 2024

Phyllis I. Cassiday, 92, a longtime resident of Liberty Center, passed away early Tuesday morning, March 26, 2024, at Christian Care Retirement Community in Bluffton.

Phyllis was born on September 26, 1931 in Wells County to J. Kelly and Cleora (Russell) Moore. She graduated from Liberty Center High School in 1949. She was the director of Medical Records for Wells Community Hospital for 23 years, retiring in 1989. She also worked on the EMS for 13 years.

Phyllis was a member of the Liberty Center Baptist Church and American Legion Post #111 Auxiliary.

On September 5, 1951, Phyllis and Dean A. Cassiday were married at the Liberty Center Baptist Church. Together they were world travelers and devout followers of the Lord. They shared 70 years of marriage before Dean's passing in 2022.

Survivors include their children; Becky (David) Foster of Casper, WY., Deana Price of Bluffton and Brian (Julie) Cassiday of Winter Garden, FL., along with 12 grandchildren, 16 great-grandchildren and 3 great-great-grandchildren.

Phyllis is preceded in death by her parents, her husband, Dean, a son, Timothy Cassiday and a daughter, Beverly Cassiday.

A memorial service will be held at 10:30 on Monday, April 29, 2024, at the Thoma/Rich, Lemler Funeral Home in Bluffton. Burial will follow at Mossburg Cemetery.

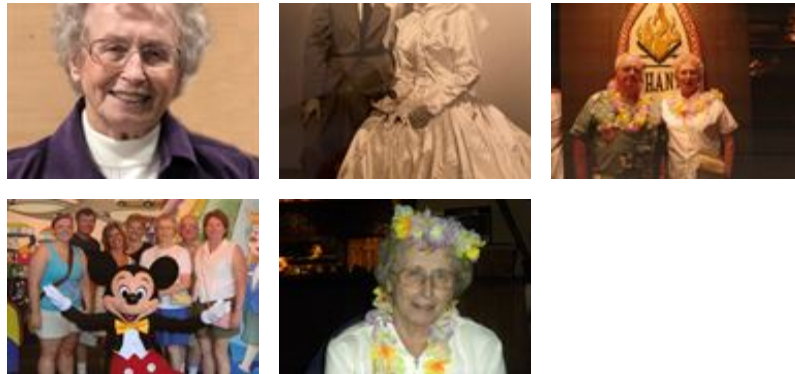
