Phyllis S. Maddux, 87, of Fort Wayne, passed away at 12:05 p.m., Thursday, September 5, 2013 at Bethlehem Woods of Fort Wayne.

Phyllis was born in Fort Wayne on March 6, 1926 to Cornelius and Madeline (Koeble) Sweeney. Her parents preceded her in death. She married William Frank Maddux on June 6, 1953 in Angola, Indiana. He preceded her in death on February 4, 1992.

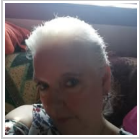

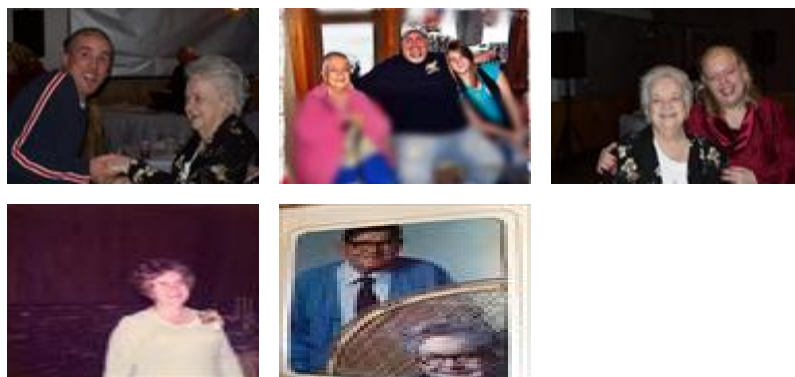
