Phyllis at the age of 79, passed away on Monday morning, April 20, 2020, at Christian Care Retirement Community in the midst of the Covid pandemic.

Phyllis was born on April 24, 1940 in Bluffton to Harold & Anna Louise (Larrimer) Farling. She was a 1958 graduate of Bluffton High School. A homemaker, Phyllis worked as a childcare provider and worked alongside her husband Clyde in the Super-market. She also worked for Home Health Care for various companies.

Phyllis was a member of Tri Kappa, pledging as a member in 1958. She was an active and associate membership chapter. She was involved in many of

the Tri Kappa Red Stocking shows.

She was an active member of the First Baptist Church in Bluffton. She served in Sunday School, Vacation Bible Schools and on many Church Committees. She was Chairman of the Trustees when the Sanctuary was renovated in 1977.

Phyllis and Clyde L. Shady were married on June 29, 1958 at the First Baptist Church.

Survivors include her husband of 61 years, Clyde of Bluffton and her children; Kent (Deb) Shady of Bluffton, Kendra Shady of Jeffersonville, Kurt (Jennifer) Shady of Milford, MA. Phyllis is also survived by 4 grandchildren; Glen (Jessica) Shady, Craig (Shelby) Shady, Isabella Shady and Jasper Shady and 5 great-grandchildren: Elizabeth Shady, Hannah Shady, Claire Shady, Maddie Shady, Crosley Shady, and a sixth great-granddaughter this December. Also, a brother, Larry (Karolyna) Farling of Bluffton.

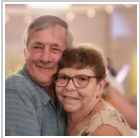
