Phyllis Ann Croy, 75, of Vera Cruz, Indiana, passed away at 7:55 p.m. Wednesday, February 23, 2011 at Blake Medical Center in Bradenton, Florida.

Born in Wells County, Indiana on August 19, 1935, she was the daughter of James Howard and Mona Maxine (Stout) Courtney, her father preceded her in death and her mother survives in Bluffton. She married Donald L. Croy in Bluffton, Indiana on June 20, 1953 and he survives.

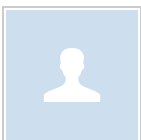
