



Ralph Urshel

July 5, 1924 - December 1, 2016

Ralph Urshel, 92, of Bluffton and a longtime resident of Ossian passed away Thursday morning, December 1, 2016, at Visiting Nurse and Hospice Home in Fort Wayne.

He was born on July 5, 1924 in Bluffton to Ralph M. Urshel, Sr. & Pearl May (Barlett) Urshel. He graduated from Ossian High School with the class of 1943 and attended some college courses at IUPUI in Fort Wayne.

On December 21, 1945 Ralph and Betty Rose (Kinsey) were married. Ralph worked as a Day Foreman at Dana Corporation in Fort Wayne, until he retired in 1981, after 34 years. Ralph and Betty then moved to Longville, Minnesota where Ralph served as a Councilman and mayor of Longville. In 2001 they moved back to Bluffton. He loved to fish and placed 4th in a walleye tournament.

Survivors include three daughters; Marjorie Smith of Huntington, Claudia (Ross) Christman of Neenah, Wisconsin and Kimberly (Mark) Pierce of Pelican Rapids, Minnesota, along with two sons: Daniel (Gina) Urshel and Brent (Bev) Urshel, both of Ossian. He is also survived by 16 grandchildren and 27 great-grandchildren and a cousin Betty Lou Dunwiddie of Bluffton. He is preceded in death by his parents and his wife Betty on July 9, 2010. A service to Celebrate Ralph's life will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday (December 15, 2016) at the Thoma/Rich, Lemler Funeral Home in Bluffton. Rev. Cindy Osgood will officiate. 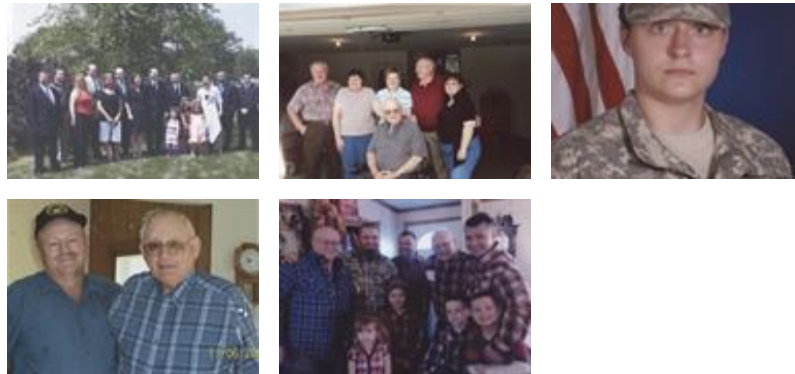
