



## Rancie Ellenberger

July 30, 1932 - December 15, 2021

Rancie Ellenberger 89, of Fort Wayne and formerly of Bluffton passed away Wednesday December 15, 2021, at the Majestic Care of Jefferson Pointe in Fort Wayne. Rancie was born July 30, 1932, in Hyden, KY to Lawrence and Lillie (Caldwell) Melton.

Rancie was a 1953 graduate of Bluffton High School.

On January 10, 1954, in Wells County, Rancie married Richard L. Ellenberger. They shared 44 years of marriage together before his passing on May 14, 1998.

Rancie was an E.R. admitting clerk for Caylor-Nickel Clinic for 22 years. In 1981 Rancie and her husband moved to Madison, TN. She worked at the Nashville Memorial Hospital for 16 years retiring in 1997. In 2000, Rancie moved back to Bluffton.

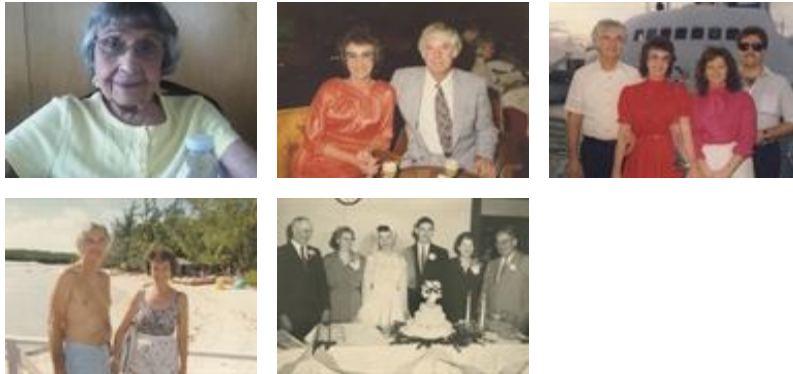
