Randall Bruce "Randy" Miller, 68, of Bluffton, passed away at 10:21 a.m. Wednesday, September 26, 2012 at St. Joseph Hospital in Fort Wayne.

Randy was born in Bluffton, Indiana on June 15, 1944 to Russell Miller and Helen (Brinneman) Miller.

Randy had resided in Bluffton for eight years and previously resided in San Antonio, Texas. He was a U.S. Air Force Veteran having served our country from February 8, 1965 to February 7, 1969 and also served in the U.S. Air Force Reserve from February 7, 1969 to February 7, 1971.
