Rebecca “Becky” L. Seeker, 55, of Bluffton fought a courageous battle with cancer and was escorted into the presence of Jesus on January 2, 2014 at Bluffton Regional Medical Center.

Becky was born on August 23, 1958 in Owosso, Michigan to Rev. Mark & Shirley (Hulliberger) Batterbee. She was a 1976 graduate of Adlai Stevenson High School in Sterling Heights, Michigan and went on to study Early Childhood Development at Bethel College in Mishawaka. For the last 17 years, she has worked as a seamstress at Smith Brothers Furniture in Berne. She was an active member of Hope Missionary Church in Bluffton.

She is survived by her children; Kacy (Abe) Haines of Bluffton, Mick (Kristiana) Seeker of Linn Grove and Brittany (Ben) Studebaker of Poneto, along with four grandchildren; Autumn & Caelyn Seeker & Foster & Conrad Studebaker. She is also survived by her father Rev. Mark Batterbee of Michigan, and siblings Debby (Dan) Raney of Florida, Kay (Pastor Gary) Aupperle of Bluffton, Pam Pierson of Arkansas, Phyllis (Wally) Hull of Fort Wayne, Mary (Todd) Granger of Florida and Mark (Tiffany) Batterbee of

She is preceded in death by her mother, Shirley Batterbee and her step-mother, Betty Batterbee.
