Reginald "Reggie" E. Ormsby 69 of Bluffton passed away at 2:09 a.m. Wednesday, June 24, 2015 at the Hospice Home in Fort Wayne.

He was born on April 14, 1946 in Bluffton, Indiana to Vaughn E. & Margie (Glander) Ormsby.

He graduated from Lancaster High School in 1964, where he was a basketball standout. He served his country with the United States Army. He lived in Texas for several years and returned to Wells County in 1985 to help build the family business. He was president of Ormsby Trucking, Inc. He served as chairman of the Indiana Motor Truck Association in 2004 and remained active as a board member and served on numerous advisory committees in the transportation industry. He was an avid golfer, loved his Corvettes and spending time with family and friends.

Reggie is survived by children: Aaron (Tanya) Ormsby of St. Louis, Britt Ormsby of Fort Wayne, and Natalie Fairchild of Bluffton. He was "Big Daddy" to his five grandchildren: Ethan, Lilly, Emme, Allison and Wes.

He is also survived by a brother Tim (Becky) Ormsby of Fort Wayne, two sisters, Julie (Randy) Holte of Bluffton and Jill Pearson of Fort Wayne along with several nieces and nephews.

He is preceded in death by his parents.

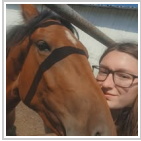

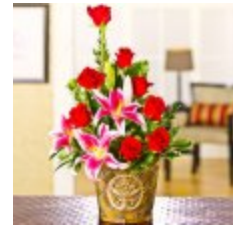
