



Rex Kreigh

March 22, 1944 - February 18, 2015

Rex A. Kreigh, 70, of Bluffton, passed away Wednesday, February 18, at home following a seven-month battle with cancer. He was born in Allen County to J. Roger “Dodge” Kreigh and Alma Lucille (Mackey) Kreigh on March 22, 1944. Rex married Billy May (Beaty) Kreigh in 1967.

Survivors include his wife, daughters Regan Ann Kreigh of Fort Wayne, and Erin Neille (Chad Carnes) Kreigh of Uniondale; one grandson, Jasper Stone Kreigh and two granddaughters, Chelsie and Alayanna Carnes. Two sisters, Karen Hall of Noblesville and Ruthann Clinkenbeard of Highland, and brothers-in-law Doug (Jan) Beaty of Anderson and Kevin (Sara) Beaty, of Bluffton. Eleven nieces and nephews also survive. Rex was preceded in death by his mother, father, and two nephews.

A 1962 graduate of Ossian High School, Rex excelled in sports, especially basketball. He is among the top 10 all-time scorers in boy’s high school basketball in Wells County. In the 1962 Bluffton Sectional Tournament championship game, he scored a record 22 points in the fourth quarter for his Ossian team, a single quarter sectional record which still stands. Rex attended Middle State Tennessee University and Taylor University on basketball scholarships. He enjoyed all sports, especially college basketball and golf, plus his family and friends, and most of all, his grandson, Jasper Stone, who he called “The Rock.”

A Memorial Service to celebrate Rex’s life will be held at the Thoma/Rich, Lemler Funeral Home, at 10:30AM on Sunday February 22, 2015. Life

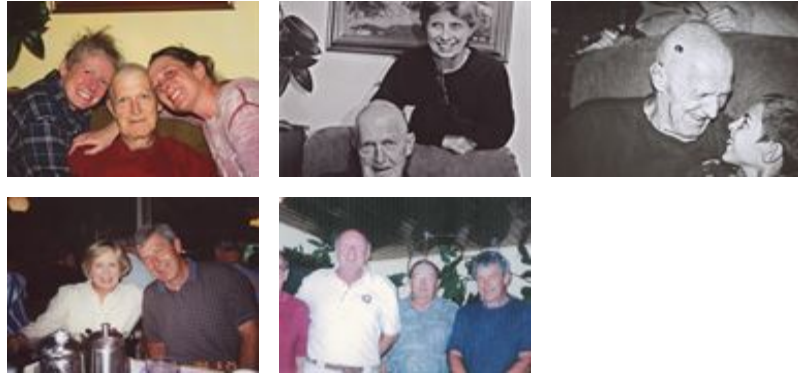
