

Mr. Richard K. Glenn

October 5, 1927 - November 29, 2013

Surrounded by family and friends, Richard K. "Dick" Glenn, 86, died Friday morning, November 29, 2013 at Bluffton Regional Medical Center. Death was due to complications of COPD.

Dick was born October 5, 1927 in Louisville, KY to Howard and Vera Fay (Hoggatt) Glenn. He was raised in Birdseye, Indiana. He married Wanda Harlen in Evansville, Indiana on March 19, 1955, and she survives.

After serving in the U.S. Army during World War II, Dick attended Purdue University and graduated in 1951 with a degree in Pharmacy. He worked for 10 years as Director of Pharmacy at Welborn Hospital and Clinic in Evansville, Indiana, and retired in 1987 from Caylor Nickel Hospital and Clinic where he had spent 10 years as Director of Pharmacy and 12 years as Director of Materials Management.

He and Wanda enjoyed many of his retirement years buying and selling antiques while visiting interesting areas of the country and acquiring many new friends. Dick was proud of his family, he loved to fish and he enjoyed a friendly game of Poker.

In addition to his wife of 58 years, he is survived by a daughter, Carol of Brownsburg, Indiana, a son, James "Jim" Glenn of Mooresville, Indiana, a

sister and brother-in-law, Judi and Al Martin, a niece, Vicki (David) Bast and a nephew, Steven Hedderick, all from St. Louis, Missouri.
He was preceded in death by his parents.

The family invites friends to join them from 2:00 to 8:00 p.m. on Wednesday, December 4th at Thoma/Rich, Chaney & Lemler Funeral Home to celebrate Dick's life and to share fond memories. At Dick's request, he will be cremated with burial at a later date in Southern Indiana. 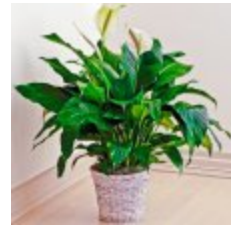
