Richard Lee Hahn, 71, of Bluffton, died at 8:10 a.m. Friday, April 23, 2010, of complications from cancer. He had been in failing health since 2006.

Mr. Hahn was a truck driver, having worked for several companies including Renners Express. After his retirement in 2001, he enjoyed working for Troyer's Foods in Berne. He was a 1957 graduate of Chester Center High School and had resided in Bluffton for 55 years. He was a member of the Bluffton Elks Lodge and attended the Park United Brethren Church.

He enjoyed gardening, canoeing, and watching Indiana University basketball. He was a loving husband, father, and grandfather. He will be missed by everyone who knew him.

Mr. Hahn was born July 22, 1938, in Middletown, Ohio, to William D. Hahn and Gladys Kincaid Hahn. He married Janice Guthrie Sept. 6, 1959, in Bluffton; the couple celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary in 2009. His wife survives in Bluffton.

Also surviving are a daughter, Christy (Bernie) Stone of Fort Wayne; two sons, Gary (Cherie) Hahn of Bluffton and Greg (Suzi) Hahn of White Plains, Md.; two granddaughters, Samantha Stone and Alex Stone, both of Fort Wayne; and a sister, Margie (Ted) Johnson of Bluffton.

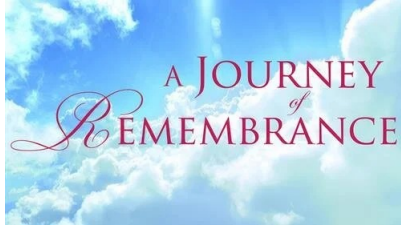
