Rita Oletta Knowles, 76, longtime resident of Poneto passed away Wednesday morning, April 19, 2023, at Christian Care Retirement Community. Rita was born in Portland, IN on December 15, 1946, a daughter of the late Nilah E (Reynolds) and Percy R Smith. Rita is survived by her sister Ghlee Dobbins and preceded in death by her sister Betty Kistler.

Rita married the late Marlin Allen Knowles, Sr in Muskegon, MI on June 3, 1966. Together they raised their four children: Lacey Knowles (Rebecca), Mak Knowles (Jennifer), Sara Muller (Rodney), and Jordan Knowles (Marie). Rita is loved by her seven grandchildren: Emma, Price, Sadie, Emmett, Myrtle, Asa, and Nilah.

Rita was a 1965 graduate of Bluffton High School and attended IU. Rita was a 23-year veteran of the US Postal Service. She was the Director of Transportation at the Council on Aging. Rita most recently was elected Council Member of the Town of Poneto, where she was a proud resident since the age of 4.

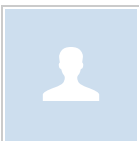
