



## Robert A. Krieg, Sr.

July 26, 1927 - March 8, 2007

Robert A. Krieg Sr., 79, of Bluffton passed away at 8:55 a.m. today, March 8, 2007, at Meadowvale Health and Rehabilitation Center. He had been in failing health the past two years.

Mr. Krieg had been a 25-year employee of Franklin Electric Co. He also had worked for Delco-Remy in Anderson, 3M Company in Hartford City and Wal-Mart in Bluffton.

He was a U.S. Army veteran with service during World War II. Mr. Krieg attended First Church of the Nazarene in Bluffton.

He was a pastor and served churches in Hartford City and Portland. He played Santa Claus for 49 years. He has been a Wells County resident since 1982.

Born on July 26, 1927, in Anderson, he was a son of Fred and Ada (Anders) Krieg. His marriage on June 10, 1995, in Frankfort, Ind., was to Marlene (Rogers) Krieg, who survives.
