Robert D. Stout, 80, of Bluffton died at 5:17 p.m on Sunday, Dec. 3, 2006 at Lutheran Hospital in Fort Wayne. He was an electric lineman with the City of Bluffton for many years, and was part of the electrical union and worked through them in cities including Fort Wayne and Gary. He was a member of American Legion Post #111 in Bluffton and the Bluffton Elks Lodge.

He was born in Bluffton on Feb. 19, 1926, a son of Robert F. and Mary D. (Crouse) Stout. He was a 1944 graduate of Bluffton High School and served in the U.S. Army from 1944 through 1946. He was married in Bluffton on Oct. 20, 2000 to Evelyn M. (Kean) Marckres, who survives.

He is also survived by his children Mrs. Tony (Susan) Palukaitis of Tampa, Fla., Mrs. Greg (Julie) Maxwell of Bluffton, Steven Miner of Fort Wayne, and David Marckres of Fort Collins, Colo., along with five grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his brother William Stout.
