Robert E. Meeks, Sr., 86, of Bluffton, died at 1:28 a.m., Saturday, December 19, 2009, at Bluffton Regional Medical Center.

Born January 6, 1923 in Wells County, to Marion Meeks and Edna (Gilbert) Meeks.

Mr. Meeks graduated from Bluffton High School, was a member of the basketball team and was active in 4-H. He was a life-long resident of Wells County where he farmed and operated a local trucking business. He was a member of Bluffton Moose Lodge #242 where he was a Past-Governor. Mr. Meeks was a U.S. Army Veteran of the Korean War and World War II. He was a member of American Legion Post # 111.
