



Robert G. "Bob" Melick

January 12, 1932 - August 16, 2010

Robert G. "Bob" Melick, 78, of Fort Wayne, a Wells County native who lived most of his life in Jay County, died Monday afternoon at the Hamilton House in Fort Wayne. Mr. Melick was a 1950 graduate of Petroleum High School. He was a farmer, and also worked at Corning Glass until it closed. He worked for 10 years at FCC in Portland until his retirement. He was an Army veteran, serving from 1952 to 1954. He was a member of the American Legion, and attended the Bryant Wesleyan Church. He was a 46-year resident of Jay County and lived in Fort Wayne for the past two years. Mr. Melick was born Jan. 12, 1932, in Wells County, to James R. Melick and Mary Irene Scott Melick. He married Kay Foltz May 5, 1956, in Wells County; his wife survives. Also surviving are five children, Kathryn (Rick) Mills of Noblesville, Monte (Brenda) Melick of Geneva, Todd (Janet) Melick of Dalton, Ohio, Scott Melick of Fort Myers, Fla., and Amy (David) Ross of Fort Wayne, and seven grandchildren, Miranda Melick and Amber Melick of Geneva, Emily Melick of Dalton, Ohio, Aaron Mills and Anne Mills, both of Noblesville, and Kayla Ross and Jared Ross, both of Fort Wayne. He was preceded in death by a brother, William S. Melick, on April 29, 1997. Calling will be from 4 to 8 p.m. Friday at the Thoma/Rich, Chaney and Lemler Funeral Home. Services will be held at the funeral home at 2:30 p.m. Saturday with Pastor Paul Van Cise officiating. Burial will be at the Elm Grove Cemetery, with military rites performed by members of Bluffton American Legion Post 111 and the U.S. Army Honor Guard.
