Robert M. "Bob" Sills, 70, of Bluffton, died unexpectedly at 2:32 p.m. Thursday, May 17, 2012 at Bluffton Regional Medical Center. 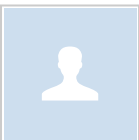

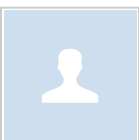
