Rodney C. Roupp Sr., 69 of Liberty Center, IN. passed away on Monday, May 9, 2022 at Parkview Regional Medical Center in Fort Wayne, IN.

Rodney was born on September 7, 1952 in Blossburg Pa. to Ross F. and Phyllis (Bailey) Roupp Jr.

Rodney served his country in the U.S. Army, where he was stationed in Korea, and Vietnam.

He worked as a printing press operator in several states, before moving to Indiana to be with his grandchildren.

He worked construction with his son before retiring from Metaldyne in Bluffton IN. in 2017.

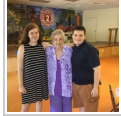
