January 9, 1928 - November 4, 2009

Roger W. Gerwig, 81, Ossian, died at 3:11 a.m. Wednesday, Nov. 4, 2009, at Lutheran Hospital in Fort Wayne. He had been in failing health the past two months. Mr. Gerwig was an Indiana State Police trooper for 27 years, retiring in 1983. After retiring from the state police, he was the security chief at Peyton's Northern for 10 years. He had also served as a trustee of the Liberty Center Baptist Church for several years. A lifelong resident of Wells County, he was a graduate of Liberty Center High School and the Indiana Police Academy. He was born Jan. 9, 1928, in Liberty Center, to Orval and Irene Eckart Gerwig. He married Mary Ann Huffman in Knightstown on May 1, 1948; his wife died Nov. 1, 1997. Survivors include two daughters, Patty (Jack) Roller of Uniondale and Peggy Cobbum of Ossian; three grandchildren, Darren Cobbum of Bluffton, Nick Roller of Uniondale, and Mandy Roller of Madison, Wis.; three great-grandchildren, four stepgrandchildren, 10 step-great-grandchildren, and six step-great-great-grandchildren; a sister, Jean (Max) Daniels of Ossian; and five nieces and nephews. Calling will be from 2 to 8 p.m. Friday at the Thoma/Rich, Chaney, and Lemler Funeral Home. Services will be held at 10:30 a.m. Saturday, Nov. 7, at the funeral home with Pastor Dan Sommer officiating. Burial will be at the Mossburg Cemetery at Liberty Center.
