



## Ron Souder

November 8, 1935 - October 28, 2008

Ron Souder, 72, of Bluffton, died at 7:25 a.m. Tuesday, Oct. 28, 2008, at Meadowvale Health and Rehabilitation Center. Born in Bluffton on Nov. 8, 1935 to Herman and Puline (Unger) Souder, he married Wilma Coffman in Trafalgar on Nov. 8, 1991; she survives. Mr. Souder attended Bluffton High School and worked for 31 years as a lineman for the City of Bluffton Utilities Department. He also worked as a farrier shoeing horses and rode horses in many parades. He attended Covenant Chapel in Bluffton.
