Ronald "Ron" D. Herman, 62 of Keystone passed away peacefully at 10:55 a.m. Saturday, April 27, 2013 at his residence surrounded by his family.

Ron was born in Decatur, Indiana on November 28, 1950, he was the son of Donald F. & Grace (Liechty) Herman and the late Lillian (Nussbaum) Herman who passed away in 1954. Grace survives in Keystone, Indiana.

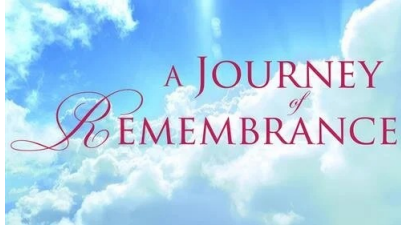
