Ruth L. Murray, 92, of Bluffton died at 10:50 a.m. on Thursday, Sept. 21, 2006 at the Christian Care Retirement Community. She had been in failing health over the past month. She was born on Aug. 17, 1914, in Lake County, the daughter of Gilbert and Mary N. (Newhard) Jarrett. She was married to Wayne A. Murray in Poneto on Jan. 4, 1932. Mr. Murray preceded her in death on July 30, 1989.

She retired in 1984 after working for 20 years as a cook in the Bluffton-Harrison School System. She attended the First Reformed Church of Bluffton. She was a lifelong resident of Wells County.
