



Ruth Marie (Gise) Hasler

July 9, 1919 - May 2, 2009

Ruth Marie Hasler 89, passed away Saturday, May 2, 2009, 12:24 p.m., at her daughter's home in Farmington Hills, Mich. Born July 9, 1919, in Cumberland, Ind., daughter of Grover and Emma Anna (Ambrose) Gise, she graduated from Indianapolis Arsenal Technical High School in 1937. She went on to graduate from St. Vincent Hospital School of Nursing in Indianapolis in 1940, followed by graduate work at Charity Hospital in New Orleans, La., then returned to Indianapolis to work as a private duty nurse. Mrs. Hasler volunteered for the Navy Nurse Corps in March of 1943; she was stationed at Pearl Harbor, Hawaii during the war and post-war at San Diego Navy Hospital in California; she was discharged as a Lieutenant in 1947. She worked at Indiana University Medical Center in Indianapolis after release from the Navy until her marriage. She also worked as a nurse at Wells Community Hospital for 18 years, serving as Director of Nursing from 1960-1967; and Veterans Hospital in Fort Wayne from 1967-1978. She was a member of Uniondale United Methodist Church. She married Lowell C. Hasler on Jan. 9, 1949, in Indianapolis; they were married 58 years; he preceded her in death in 2006. Mrs. Hasler is survived by a brother, Alan Gise of Santa Fe, N.M.; two sons, Edward (Karen) Hasler of Plymouth, Mich. and Steven (Judy) Hasler of Adell Wis.; a daughter, Margaret Hasler of Farmington Hills, Mich.; and three grandchildren. She was preceded in death by three sisters. Funeral service is 10:30 a.m. Wednesday at Thoma/Rich, Chaney & Lemler Funeral Home in Bluffton, with calling one hour prior to service. Pastor Troy Drayer officiating.

Friends are invited to visit with Ruth's family from 5 to 7 p.m. Tuesday at the funeral home. Burial in Horeb Cemetery, Uniondale, Ind. Military Graveside honors will be performed by American Legion Post 111 of Bluffton and the United States Navy Honor Guard.
