



## Sally A. Krinn

January 31, 1938 - October 13, 2014

Sally A. Krinn, 76, of Uniondale passed away on Monday, October 13, 2014, at Lutheran Hospital in Fort Wayne.

Mrs. Krinn was born on January 31, 1938 in Wells County to Daniel & Ermine (Neel) Michael. A lifelong resident of Wells County, she graduated from Rockcreek High School. On July 21, 1957, in Uniondale, she married Dale D. Krinn. He preceded her in death on December 29, 2009.

Mrs. Krinn worked on the family farm with her husband Dale and four children. She was a longtime member of St. Mark's Lutheran Church in Uniondale and served as the church organist for more than 40 years. She enjoyed traveling with her husband and spending time with her grandchildren and family.
