The mother of Dr. Walter O. Erxleben Jr. of Bluffton, Sally L. Erxleben, 94, of Bluffton died at 12:15 a.m. today, Monday, Oct. 9, 2006, at Christian Care Retirement Community.

Mrs. Erxleben had lived in Bluffton since 2000. She previously had resided in Chicago, Batesville, Ind., and Cincinnati.

Born on Oct. 1, 1912, in Toledo, Ohio, she was a daughter of William and E. Viola Githens, and was a 1936 graduate of the University of the City of Toledo.
