Sharon K. Beechler, 73 of rural Bluffton passed away on Tuesday evening at her residence.

Sharon was born on July 11, 1941 in Wells County to Everett N. & Ruth L. (Radenbaugh) Johnson. She was a 1959 graduate of Petroleum High School and a graduate of Warner School of Cosmetology.

On January 26, 1962 in Wells County, Indiana Sharon and Jerry L. Beechler were married. A homemaker, Sharon also helped on the family farm and was an active member of the Extension Homemakers Club, where she served as a past president. She was also a member of the West Missionary Church in Berne where she served for many years in the children's department.

Sharon is survived by her husband Jerry of Bluffton along with two sons; Todd A. Beechler of Berne and Tab R. Beechler of Bluffton, along with a granddaughter Shelby A. Beechler of Bluffton and a great-grandson Jordan Beechler also of Bluffton.

She is preceded in death by her parents and two sisters Geraldine Dick and Shirley Orr.

A service to celebrate Sharon's life will be held at 2 p.m. on Sunday,

November 2, 2014 at West Missionary Church in Berne, with calling for one hour prior to the service. Pastor Keith Rupp will officiate. Burial will follow at Six Mile Cemetery. 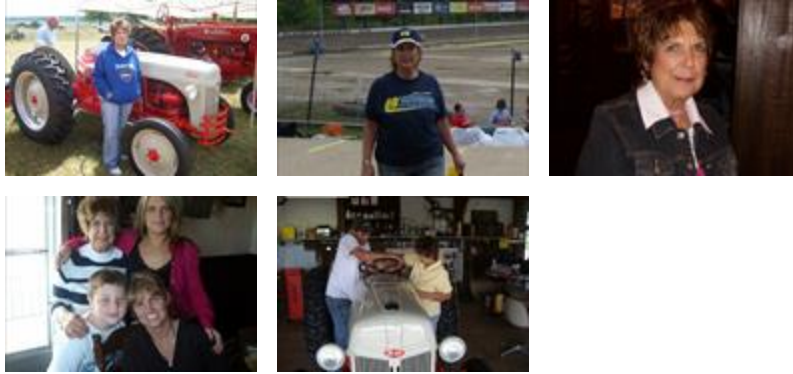
