Suze Ann Eichhorn, 88, of Huntington, passed away at 9:45 a.m. Friday, November 30, 2012 at Christian Care Retirement Community in Bluffton where she received care for the past two weeks. She had been a resident of the Tipton House in Huntington since 2009.

Suze Ann was born on September 29, 1924 in Bluffton to C. Frank & Ethel (Rex) Ulmer. She graduated from Bluffton High School with the class of 1942. On February 18, 1946 at the First Baptist Church in Bluffton, she married Robert P. Eichhorn. They shared 50 years of marriage together before he preceded her in death on September 11, 1996.

A homemaker, she was a long standing member of the First Baptist Church in Bluffton and attended the Northview Church of Christ in Huntington. She was very active volunteering in the community.
