



## Thomas E. Irvin III

November 15, 1944 - February 28, 2008

Thomas E. Irvin III, 63, of Bluffton, died at 3:30 p.m. Wednesday, Feb. 27, 2008, at Scott Memorial Hospital in Scottsburg.

Born in Bluffton on Nov. 15, 1944 to Thomas E. and Gloria (Hughes) Irvin II, he married Martha Masterson in Bluffton on Aug. 18, 1970; she survives.

Mr. Irvin attended Central High School in Fort Wayne. He was a truck driver for Madison Silo Company until Parkinson's Disease forced him to retire.

Other surviving relatives include his father; two stepdaughters, Linda Aker of Bluffton and Sherry Somerville of Fort Wayne; three stepsons, Mike, Barry and Rick Overmier, all of Bluffton; one sister, Anna Orlow of North Carolina; eight step-grandchildren and 12 step-great-grandchildren; four nephews, Daniel Newsom, Ben Newsom, Andrew Newsom and Aaron Newsom.
