Tony L. Beck, 76 of Keystone, passed away Sunday morning, June 13, 2021 at his residence surrounded by his family.

He was born on March 28, 1945 in Marion, Indiana to LeRoy and Thelma (Campbell) Beck. Tony graduated from Van Buren High School in 1963. He worked for International Harvester for 16 years prior to becoming a Nationally Registered Paramedic. Tony worked for the Wells County EMS for 28 years before his retirement. Tony was a member of the Petroleum United Methodist Church.
