Tracy A. Rigby, 53, of Bluffton, died at 6:50 p.m. Wednesday, June 23, 2010, at Bluffton Regional Medical Center. Mr. Rigby was born in South Bend on Sept. 4, 1956 to Stanley E. and R. Marilyn (Erickson) Rigby. He married Ann Chaffins in Geneva on Oct. 27, 1974; she survives.

A 1974 graduate of South Adams High School, Mr. Rigby has worked at Pretzels in Bluffton for the past one and a half years. He was the owner and operator of Shaver's Unlimited for the last 30 years. He loved woodworking and was the ultimate handy man. He lived in Wells County for 31 years.
