May 22, 1918 - July 3, 2008

Vivian R. Stinson, 90, of Bluffton, died at 6:35 p.m. Thursday, July 3, 2008, at Christian Care Retirement Center in Bluffton.

Born in Portland on May 22, 1918 to William E. and Mary (Lingo) Guldice, she married Forrest Stinson in Bluffton on Nov. 30, 1941; he preceded her in death on June 1, 1991. A 1937 graduate of Hartford City High School, Mrs. Stinson worked in the cafeteria at Southern Wells High School for many years, and also in food service at Cooper's Community Care and McDonald's in Bluffton. She was a member of Eastern Star and Rebekah Lodge #83, and Keystone United Methodist Church.
