A former Keystone resident, Wiladean M. Paxson, 84, died at 8:20 a.m. Tuesday, Nov. 21, 2006 at the Warren United Methodist Memorial Home. Born in Grant County Nov. 27, 1921, to Virgil and Lochia Hahn Brown, she married Carl Paxson in Muncie Jan. 19, 1945. He preceded her in death April 7, 1998.
