Winnie I. Markley, 89 of Bluffton, passed away on Monday, August 03, 2020, at Bluffton Regional Medical Center.

She was born on July 22, 1931 in Wells County, Indiana to Simon Baller & Mildred (Estes) Baller-Williams.

Winnie graduated from Bluffton High School. A homemaker, she worked at the Dutch Mill in Bluffton for some time. For many years, Winnie answered letters that children placed in "Santa's Mailbox" at her home and mailed each child a personalized response from Santa.

On September 7, 1952 in Mt. Zion, Winnie and V. Wayne Markley were married. They shared 63 years of marriage before he preceded her in death on June 20, 2016.

Survivors include two sons, Kevin Markley and Tracy Markley, both of Bluffton along with four grandchildren: Shane Graham, Derek Graham, Seth Markley and Travis Markley and 14 great-grandchildren and a brother Steve (Sue) Baller of Bluffton.

Winnie is preceded in death by her daughter, Debra Graham, a son, Mike Markley, a grandson Shannon Graham and a great-granddaughter Kaeli Graham along with two sisters, Bonnie Pursley & Mona Jean Dunn, a brother, Gale "Smokey" L. Baller and her twin brother, Jimmie T. Baller.

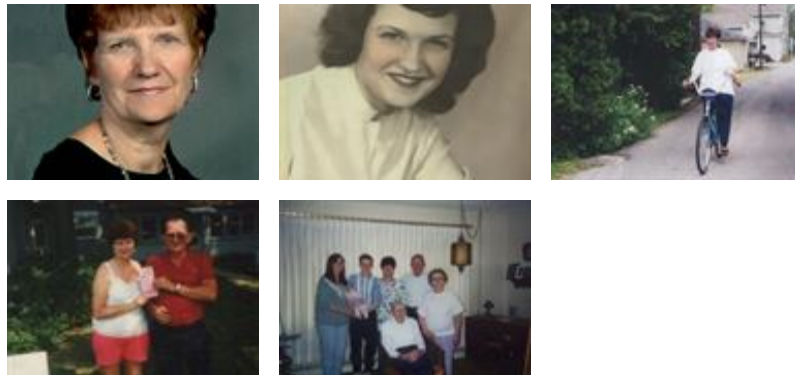
